CHAPTER TWO

DANGERS OF CULTISM

When you join the cult, any cult for that matter, you are exposed to all sorts of anti-human vices. First and foremost you are dehumanised and rendered a dependent factor. You will lose your independence to a group of disoriented persons. Freedom of mind and action is a very important human factor.

You were all created free and deserve to stay free. Even God gives you the freedom of thinking. Why should you then submit your thoughts to the directive of a backward and evil group, whose sole agenda is to intimidate, maim and kill.?

When you join the cult you are bound to lose your personality. You now become timid unless you are "charged up". You are scared of being found out all the time and therefore you are suspicious of everybody around you. No matter how hard you try, your personality is certainly affected.

Because your personality is lost, your confidence breaks down. You now operate only when in the company of "bad guys". You fail at interviews because of this. You then become a likely candidate for the group of drop-outs.

When your personality crashes and your self-confidence is lost, your cult friends and brothers cannot help you because they cannot help themselves. You are now exposed to drugs to 'charge you up' or lift you. Cultism will make you take drugs, as you won't be able to avoid the urge. So you are advised to stay out of the cults. Don't join them.

You can see from the above, the simple relationship between cultism, loss of personality, breakdown of confidence and drug addiction. When these factors come together, you are definitely on the fringe of frustration. You miss classes, you fail your test and assignments, you have carry-forward courses, you drop in the class and you become very frustrated. The deep frustration will drive you more into drugs.

Drugs are not good for learning. Drugs don't enhance confidence. Drugs give a false thrill and fake personality. When you take drugs you are pushed to test your "restored" confidence and you can only try to do this in crime. This is when you get involved in examination malpractice. This is also when you get involved in prostitution and stealing in order to have more funds to buy more drugs. You may also be involved in rape and be easily lured into other crimes. You do not need to expose yourself to all these dangers. Therefore, don't join the cults for the dangers are enormous.

You may honestly want to ask: What really are the activities of the cults? A cultist is simply a criminal. He becomes a notorious person not a popular student. When a crime is committed anywhere you are the prime suspect as a cultist. Even a robbery committed outside the campus exposes the cultist as a first suspect. This is simply because the activities of the cultist are identical to those of the street bandit and his instruments for plying his trade are also the same. Because cult activity is mainly and essentially carried out at night, you are prone to injury even from your co-travellers in the cults. When you commit a crime as a cultist, you live in fear. Even your conscience haunts you. You are at war with your environment and those who are supposed to be your friends. Do

you know that it is your colleagues in the cult, those you wine and "soak" with that tell others who you are and your activities?

In the cults you are trained and encouraged to maim and kill. You are indoctrinated to butcher and execute a fellow MAN. What a wild life!. Because you are at war, you can get killed, or injured by members of rival cults. You carry a gun, so you can be shot: you carry a knife and /or dagger, so you can also be "sliced" and or stabbed.
